Early this morning, officers had to tow a few vehicles that were left downtown blocking the farmers market area. An officer investigated a domestic violence incident that occurred last night. The female victim reported it this morning after leaving her apartment last night to get away from her boyfriend. The suspect boyfriend was not located but is wanted for felony domestic battery. Officers responded to a security check on a 77 year old male who was suicidal. He had ingested all his pills in attempt to die. He was transported to the hospital by ambulance and a mental health evaluation. This afternoon, a male reported he purchase a storage unit a few weeks ago and found a cannon ball in the unit. He took it to his apartment and posted it for sale. He began getting feedback that it might be loaded and explosive so he called TPD. We contacted the SO bomb unit who responded to handle x-raying it and safely collecting it.
